Martin Rohsmann and Ilona Seiffert are on the governing board of Stiftung-hope.

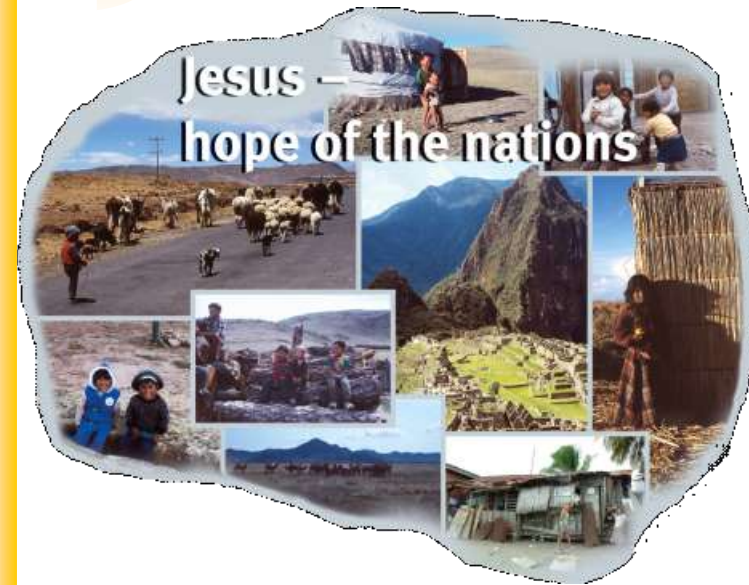

# Projects

## Philippines

'Outcasts' such as gamblers, alcoholics, pick-pockets, and other needy people are being equipped for a new life with Jesus thru Family-Care-Groups and a pioneering church in the poverty stricken Bucana area, Davao City, on the Island of Mindanao. Malnourished and handicapped children who suffer from developmental and growth deficiencies receive food, medicines, care and love through the Rescue-a-Child feeding program in the newly established feeding center. With only one Euro per day you can personally rescue a child.

Missionary Christian Wagner with his Filipino wife Adela are founders of "Light in Asia" with the vision of: Discipling and equipping the peoples of Asia to intimately know Jesus Christ and to make Him known among the unreached. This is being accomplished through two areas of ministry:

1. Pioneering a spirit-filled Church among the poor in Bucana, Davao City and
2. Mobilizing, training and sending Filipino missionaries to unreached Buddhist peoples of Asia.



## Mongolia

Street children climb through the duct cover to spend the night in the community heating system of Ulaanbaatar, the coldest capital city in the world. They are covering close together to survive the cold which is below than -30 °C (-22 ° Fahrenheit). HELP International Mongolia installed an emergency room, a soup kitchen and a training class in a newly founded care centre to relieve the distress of these people.



## Siberia

Hundreds of people, families with children or even homeless children are living on the city rubbish dump near Novosibirsk. These children haven't been to school for years. The children get a meal and are taught by volunteers to bring them to a level so they can visit public school again. It is planned to organize the feeding programs on a regular basis and build a house where the children can stay and hear the word of God.



## Peru

The centre of the Evangelical Association Chacra de Dios is situated 12 km from the city of Juliaca in the highlands of Peru. Peter and Kerstin Kinast, a German missionary couple, who, since 1998, have led a congregation in Juliaca as pastors, founded this training and retreat centre for evangelical leaders and Peruvian people. Because these people are very poor, they need financial support. A vision is to establish a Christian school for Peruvian children.
